Your resubmission of September 20, 1991 entailing an amendment request for a change in formulation, revised product labeling, and a product name change has been reviewed and the following comments apply.

Product Name Change

The proposed product name change from "Biocare 90-T" to "Biocare 90-T 3" Tablets" is acceptable.

Product Chemistry

The product chemistry data enclosed with this submission, including 12 month storage and stability data, for the 99.0% trichloro-s-triazinetriene product is in compliance with 40 CFR part 158.155 through 158.190 and is acceptable.

Product Labeling

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before you release the product for shipment.

- In the "Ingredient Statement", do not line up the "90% available chlorine" directly underneath the numeric values of the ingredients as it is confusing to the reader.
