This is in response to your amendment to reflect product name change from "Crystal Pure Chlorinating Sticks" to "Crystal Care Chlorinating sticks".

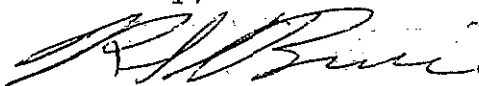

The amendment to change the dosage of "10,000 gallons" to "5,000 gallons" of pool water under the "Directions for Use" is not acceptable.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Adjust and maintain pool water pH in the range of 7.2-7.8 as indicated by available test kit. Use suitable agents to lower or increase pH. Follow instructions for use on the label of these products.
2. For maximum effectiveness it is recommended that the pool be first stabilized with 40-60 ppm Cyanuric Acid to reduce chlorine loss in sunlight. Follow instructions on the label of the product used.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

PRODUCT IS STRONG OXIDIZER AND CONTACT WITH ORGANIC MATTER MAY CAUSE FIRE.
CONTACT WITH WATER LIBERATES IRRITATING CHLORINE CONTAINING GASES.
AT TEMPERATURES ABOVE 325°F DECOMPOSES WITH LIBERATION OF TOXIC GASES.
IN CASE OF FIRE OR THERMAL DECOMPOSITION ISOLATE CONTAINER AND FLOOD WITH LARGE AMOUNTS OF WATER.

CRYSTAL CARE introduces chlorine and additional Cyanuric Acid into the pool to assure the stabilizing effect.

3. Place one (1) skimmer stick per 5000 gallons of pool water every week into suitable feeder or directly into a stick skimmer basket.

A free available chlorine level of 1.0-1.5 ppm should be maintained. Check pool frequently with a test kit and maintain residual chlorine level between 1.0 and 1.5 ppm and pH of 7.2-7.8.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IN CASE OF CONTACT WITH SKIN

IF SWALLOWED

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
