1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 57901-8."

b. In the Ingredient statement, revise "Available Chlorine 56%" to "Available Chlorine 55%".

c. Revise the product name to: Biocare 55 Granular.

d. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, revise "stress" to "stream" in the "If In Eyes" instructions.

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e. Revise the first paragraph of the Precautionary statements to read: "CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe dust, vapor, or spray mist."

f. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement according to PR Notice 93-10: "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS**

Sodium Dichloro-s-Triazinetrione 99%

Dihydrate 1%

**INERT INGREDIENTS**

Available chlorine 56%

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Store in dry, cool and well-ventilated area. Avoid moisture getting into container.

Keep off wet floors. In case of spillage wash with large amounts of water. After each use, re-line polyethylene liner and keep container tightly closed. Oxidizing material. Keep away from flames, sparks and all sources of heat. Avoid contact with organic material.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
