On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

- c. Under the "Environmental Hazards" Statement add as the first sentence "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms".
- d. You must place your "EPA Establishment Number" on your label.

3. You must submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula and change the term "humidity" to "water" on your CSF. Humidity is a descriptor of a condition and does not disclose the chemical.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
