GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling. Have available gas masks approved by the US Bureau of Mines or the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health. Handle and use only in accordance with practice recommended in the Chlorine Manual published by the Chlorine Institute, Inc. Use only in well ventilated areas

Only specially designed dispensing equipment should be used, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and with the Chlorine Institute's recommendations. Dosages of residual chlorine levels which should be maintained for any specific site of application must be consistent with recommended practice and state and municipal recommendations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep containers away from heat. Do not store in direct sunlight or drop portable containers. All storage containers must have weather resistant labels attached near outlet valves and must not be accessible to the general public. Empty containers should be properly identified with return tags and returned to supplier according to prescribed instructions and practices recommended by the Chlorine Institute.
