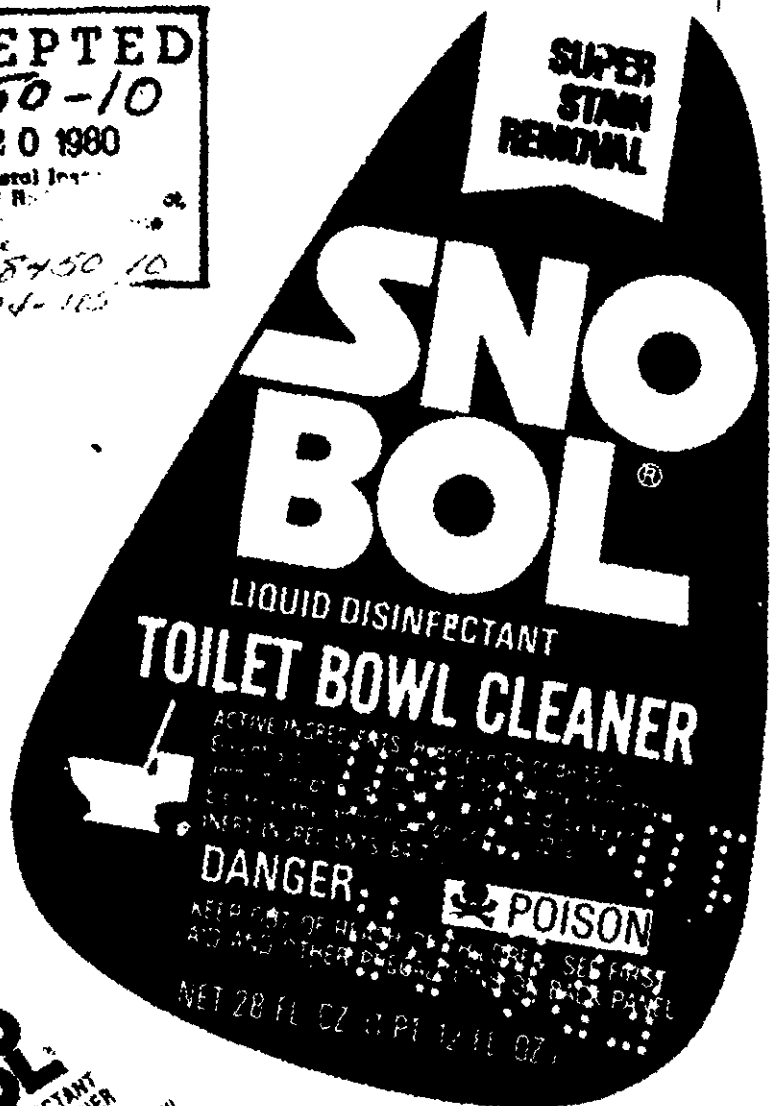
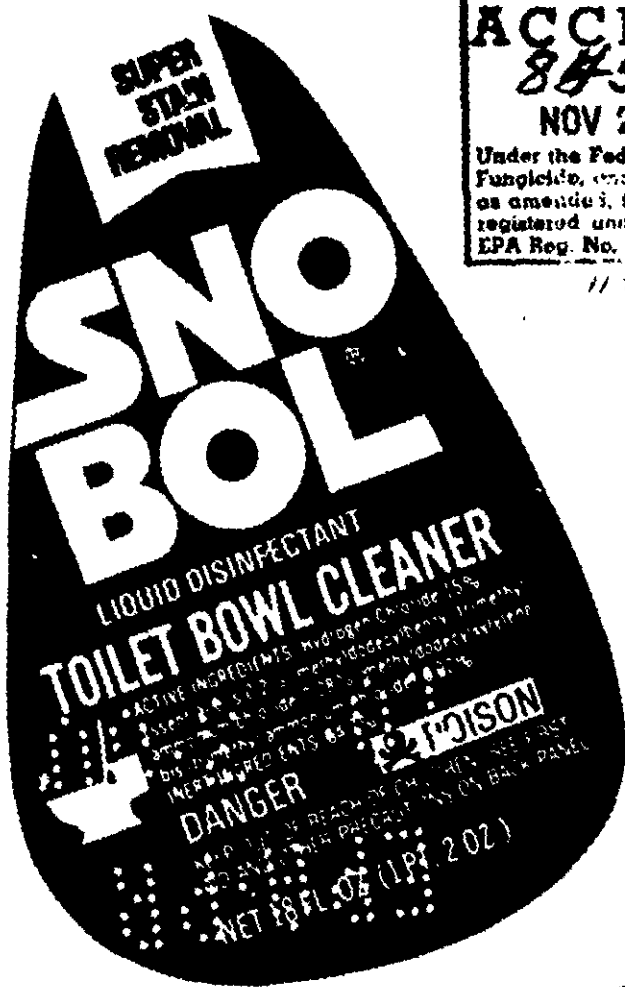

SNO BOL

LIQUID DISINFECTANT TOILET BOWL CLEANER

KILLS HOUSEHOLD GERMS, INCLUDING STAPH IN BATHROOM BOWL

Stops odors. Removes stubborn rust and hard water stains. Leaves fresh clean fragrance. Safe for white and colored bowls. Will not harm septic tanks.

Directions: Point arrow away from you when opening or closing cap. After opening the cap point the top of the bottle down into the bowl. Squeeze gently in order to determine the direction of the spray. Brush entire bowl especially under the rim, the hard water ring and below the water line then flush.

For badly discolored bowls remove water from bowl and brush out with 4 to 8 oz SNO BOL. For fresh stains shut water pressure off and flush to empty tank. Squeeze SNO BOL on brush or mop to clean tank.

To Disinfect: Remove water from bowl. Cover all surfaces of bowl interior with SNO BOL. Brush thoroughly and flush.
