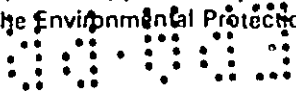

WC 630

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use.

For pools having just visible algae growth, add WC 630 fluid ounces of WC 630 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of WC 630 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initial dose of WC 630 per 1000 gallons of water.

For hot tubs, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains, should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

WC 630 should be used to treat pools and spas and is not to be used in conjunction with other chlorine chemicals and may reduce the effectiveness of other chlorine chemicals. However, do not mix WC 630 with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be stored away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers.
