minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and  
heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use.

WC 625  
For pools having just visible algae growth add a  
fluid ounces of WC 625  
move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a  
pool add initially 27 to 50 fluid ounces  
per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions  
of WC 625 per 10,000 gallons  
7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains  
require an initial dose of 5 to 8 fluid ounces  
per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub,  
hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially WC 625  
per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of  
treatments of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of  
should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.  
WC 625 is for use  
used to treat pools and spas and is effective.  
WC 625 can be used with  
chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine.  
However, do not mix WC 625 with other  
liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.
