

in recirculating commercial and industrial water treatment systems must be cleaned to remove algal and other deposits. An initial slug addition of WC 615

per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 0.5 WC 615

per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store more than five drums high.
