

b. Add the word "Pesticide" before the word storage in the Storage and Disposal section.

c. Revise the Precautionary statement to read as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling"

d. The first aid statement must be revised to read as follows:

Follow manufactures' instructions for cleaning/maintaining Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). If no such instructions for washables use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

- g. Add the following user safety recommendation statements to the label.

**User Safety Recommendations**

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label bearing the revisions prior to releasing this product for sale.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**General Comment:**

Note that the nominal concentration of the active ingredient in Wocosen Technical (EPA Reg. No. 43813-13) was confirmed to be 95% and not 88% as was listed in the EPA database. The requirements of PR Notice 91-2 are therefore satisfied.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### SAPSTAIN CONTROL

For control of mold and fungus on green or freshly cut lumber, this product may be combined with other Contechem Sapstain Control products to give a concentration of 0.050-0.20% of Propiconazole in the end-use treating solution. It may be used in dip or spray applications. For specific recommendations and technical service, contact Contechem at 877-283-3021.

For best results, green wood should be treated immediately, at least within twenty-four hours after cutting or sawing. Mold and fungus growth begins immediately after cutting so delayed treatment is much less effective and requires increased chemical concentration. Green, untreated lumber should not be used for stickers.

Freshly treated lumber should not be allowed to remain unprotected in heavy rains. Dip tanks and drip aprons must be roofed, paved and drained to prevent dilution and loss of the anti-stain solution.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in original container in a cool dry place.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
