Point valve opening away from face and press button. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

FOR USE AS AN AREA SPRAY OUTDOORS

Patios - Yards - Open porches
To reduce Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats And
small flying moths:

Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL INDOORS	Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward
FLIES	into center of room with a slow sweeping motion.
MOSQUITOES	Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed
SMALL FLYING MOTHS	for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room
GNATS	thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy
WASPS:	fallen insects.

TO KILL INDOORS	Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in
COCKROACHES	addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room
ANTS	suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention
CRICKETS	should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants treat doors, around window frames, and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

IF SWALLOWED: call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
