
D'RECTIONS FOR USE: IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A M. ANER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. 28oz. This algaedde is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this algaecide. 2607. For pools naving just visible sigae growth add an initial dose of 24 to 36 fluid dunces of this algaedide per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 13 to 24 fluid ounces of this algaeolds per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 to 9 fluid ounces of this algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance. 24oz. Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of algaecide per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub add initially 1 to 2 fluid ounces of algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial 22oz. treatment for maintenance. This algaecide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This algaecide can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.
