This is in response to your resubmission dated July 9, 1990 in regard to your request to amend the registration of this product to change the signal word from "WARNING" to "DANGER" based on information from your supplier.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

- 1) Make the following labeling revision before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - Delete the first referral statement (i.e., See additional Precautionary Statements on the back panel) located beneath the signal word DANGER on the front panel. (Please note that we did not intend for this statement to appear in two places on the front panel.)
- 2) Submit the final printed labeling for inclusion in the product file.
