I am resubmitting the notification to revise the pesticide container disposal language per PR Notice 2007-4 for the above referenced product, in response to the Agency letter dated June 9, 2010. I am enclosing EPA Form 8570-1, two copies of the Master Label (one copy with changes clearly marked in red and one clean copy), and a copy of the Agency letter dated June 9, 2010.

“Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA’s regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.”

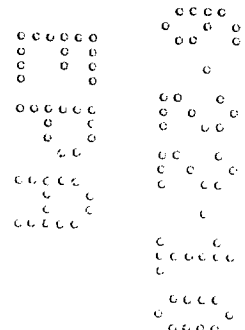

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

**FIRST AID**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth- to- mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Chemtrec 1-800-424-9300.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

**Note to Physician:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WINTERIZER algaecide will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 41 to 65 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 76 to 117 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algaecide throughout the water and pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

WINTERIZER is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and effective at both acid and alkaline pH. WINTERIZER can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix WINTERIZER with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

*(Household / Residential Use)*

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash or offer for recycling if available.

*(Commercial / Industrial / Institutional Use)*

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking or damaged containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. Mop up spills with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and stored away from food.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes may be hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**Container Handling:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
