



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use water containing residue from use of this product to irrigate crops used for food or feed.

INITIAL APPLICATION FOR SWIMMING POOLS (To A Clear Pool) Two gallons ALGAE INHIBITOR to each 50,000 gallons of water or ratio

thereof. If Algae growth is visible apply the initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.

CONTINUED APPLICATION

Two quarts **ALGAE INHIBITOR** in 50,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Quaternary Test Kits are available for this use.

BOOSTER APPLICATION

-Two quarts **ALGAE INHIBITOR** in 50,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DANGER: HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves, and protective clothing. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- STORAGE: Store in original containers and place in locked storage area inaccessible to children and individuals unfamiliar with its use. Keep from freezing.

- unused product down an indoor or outdoor drain.
