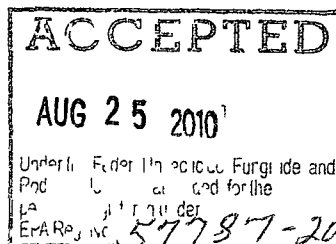

INITIAL APPLICATION FOR SWIMMING POOLS *(To a Clear Pool)*

Two gallons ALGAE INHIBITOR to each 50,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof If algae growth is visible apply the initial dose Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of algae

CONTINUED APPLICATION

Two quarts ALGAE INHIBITOR in 50,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active Quaternary Test Kits are available for this use

BOOSTER APPLICATION

Two quarts ALGAE INHIBITOR in 50,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load

ALGAE INHIBITOR is compatible with many swimming pool chemicals and when used as directed it is not harmful to metal, paint, plastic, or tile surfaces of the swimming pool

ALGAE INHIBITOR when used as directed will help improve the appearance and cleanliness of the swimming pool water

ALGAE INHIBITOR helps inhibit the growth of unsightly algae,

ALGAE INHIBITOR when properly stored for prolonged periods of time, will not lose its effectiveness or strength

ALGAE INHIBITOR requires no special equipment for treating swimming pool water The correct use dilution may be added directly to the pool in any spot, or added to the water circulation equipment
