- 3. Disconnect slide and automatic pool cleaner from pool support system.
- 4. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.4 range.
- 5. Raise chlorine residual to 3 ppm.
- 6. Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine.
- 7. Add this product through skimmer at a rate of 8 oz. every 10 minutes until the recommended dosage of 16 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add this product below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above.
- 8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment.
- 9. For best result, keep filter in operation until condition clears.
- 10. Influent water temperature must be limited to 72° Fahrenhiet.

FOR WEEKLY PREVENTION TREATMENT OF NON-VISIBLE ALGAE

- 1. Clean tile on pool.
- 2. Backwash filter.
- 3. Disconnect slide and automatic pool cleaner from pool support system.
- 4. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.4 range.
- 5. Raise chlorine residual to 3 ppm.
- 6. Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine.
- 7. Add this product through skimmer at the rate of 8 oz. every 10 minutes until the recommended dosage of 4 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add this product below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above.
- 8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment.
- 9. For best result, keep filter in operation until condition clears.
- 10. Influent water temperature must be limited to 72° Fahrenheit.

FOR WINTERIZING BEFORE FREEZING

- 1. Clean tile on pool.
- 2. Backwash filter.
- 3. Disconnect slide and automatic pool cleaner from pool support system.
- 4. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.4 range.
- 5. Raise chlorine residual to 3 ppm.
- 6. Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine.
- 7. Add this product through skimmer at the rate of 8 oz. every 10 minutes until the recommended dosage of 48 oz. per 10,000 gallons of pool water is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add this product below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above.
- 8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

(Household / Residential Use)

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash or offer for recycling if available.

(Commercial / Industrial / Institutional Use)

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product dry in a tightly sealed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding the container. KEEP FROM FREEZING.
