DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MAN-NER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.

STORAGE: Keep product in a locked storage area and store in original container.

Avoid storage near feed and food products.

DISPOSAL: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

"Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of an site or at an approved waste disposal facility." Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. Apply the recommended rate of this product at the end of the day when the pool is empty. After treatment, surfaces should be scrubbed to dislodge killed algae and the pool should be vacuumed to remove dead or settled algae. In addition to the treatment, algae occurring in deep cracks or cravices may require additional

scrubbing and vacuuming.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE
Pools having visible algae: Add an initial dose of 18-24 ft. oz. of this product per

10,000 gallons of water.

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To maintain pools free of visible algae growth: Additions of 6-10 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial breakment.

READ AND FOLLOW THE LABEL DIRECTIONS GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both alkaline and acid pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine preducts.

This product will control almost all of the green and blue-green algae commonly occurring in swimming pool situations. Phormidium inudatum, commonly called Black Algae, will be controlled with this product although some scrubbing may be

required to loosen the killed algae.
