The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

**Conditions**

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the phrase "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."

2. Separate the headings "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" and "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" so that they are listed individually on the product label.

3. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

4. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to read:

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**



28oz.	<b>DIRECTIONS FOR USE</b> IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.
26oz.	Apply the recommended rate of this product at the end of the day when the pool is empty. After treatment, surfaces should be scrubbed to dislodge killed algae and the pool should be vacuumed to remove dead or settled algae. In addition to the treatment, algae occurring in deep cracks or crevices may require additional scrubbing and vacuuming.
24oz.	<b>RECOMMENDATION FOR USE</b> Pools having visible algae: Add an initial dose of 18 - 24 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.
22oz.	To maintain pools free of visible algae growth: Additions of 6-10 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.
20oz.	<b>READ AND FOLLOW THE LABEL DIRECTIONS</b> <b>GENERAL INFORMATION</b> This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both alkaline and acid pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
18oz.	This product will control almost all of the green and blue-green algae commonly occurring in swimming pool situations. <i>Phormidium inudatum</i> , commonly called Black Algae, will be controlled with this product although some scrubbing may be required to loosen the killed algae.
16oz.	<b>PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS/ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS</b> <b>FISH CAUTION</b> THIS PRODUCT IS TOXIC TO FISH. Do not use in any water where fish are present.
