3. Place "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" below the Precautionary Statement heading.
4. The statement directly below the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals should read:

Danger. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear protective eye wear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses). Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.
