ProTeam Supreme is specially formulated to enhance water quality by improving filtration and controlling algae. Use of this product promotes sparkling, clear water and reduces eye and skin irritation for swimmers.

Supreme provides long-lasting algae suppression, controlling all types of algae found in swimming pools, as well as aiding in the removal of existing algae stains.

- 1.) For initial application, introduce two pounds of **ProTeam Supreme** per each one thousand gallons of pool water by broadcasting the material over the surface area of the pool with a pump running. This initial treatment must be added in two doses with one half of the necessary amount being added in each application. For initial pH adjustment use ¾ pound ProTeam pH Down (Sodium Bisulfate) or 10 ounces of muriatic acid for each pound of **ProTeam Supreme**, mixing acid in a bucket of water, then add to pool.
- 2.) The pH of the pool water may rise as a normal reaction to the introduction of **ProTeam Supreme**. After a normal turnover of pool water adjust the pH to 7.4-7.6 using a reliable acid demand kit. **ProTeam Supreme** is compatible with all materials normally used in swimming pool maintenance.
- 3.) Test the pool water a minimum once a week or as normally required by local Health Authority Regulations. Sanitizer levels need to be maintained at levels indicated on the sanitizer label. The **ProTeam Supreme** residual must be tested at least once each month and must be maintained at 30-50 ppm. Your ProTeam Dealer can provide this test and water analysis.
- 4.) **ProTeam Supreme** is lost from water only through filter backwash and splash-out.

WINTERIZATION

A pool that has been treated with **ProTeam Supreme** will remain clear and be beautiful throughout the winter months with little or no effort. The pool must be tested to assure that an adequate level of **ProTeam Supreme** is present before shut down. See your ProTeam Dealer for freeze protection information.
