The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Boric Acid Amended Interim Registration Review Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised

labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. See FIFRA section 2(p)(2). If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process, FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(B). Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Before draining a treated [pool,] or [spa,] contact your local sanitary sewer and storm drain authorities and follow their discharge instructions. Do not discharge treated pool, spa, or hot tub water to any location that flows to a gutter, storm drain or natural water body unless discharge is allowed by state and local authorities.

ProTeam Supreme is specially formulated to enhance water quality by improving filtration and controlling algae. Use of this product promotes sparkling, clear water and reduces eye and skin irritation for swimmers.

ProTeam Supreme provides long-lasting algae suppression, controlling all types of algae found in swimming pools, as well as aiding in the removal of existing algae stains.

- 1.) For initial application, introduce two pounds of **ProTeam Supreme** per each one thousand gallons of pool water by broadcasting the material over the surface area of the pool with a pump running. This initial treatment must be added in two doses with one half of the necessary amount being added in each application. For initial pH adjustment use ¾ pound ProTeam pH Down (Sodium Bisulfate) or 10 ounces of muriatic acid for each pound of **ProTeam Supreme**, mixing acid in a bucket of water, then add to pool.
- 2.) The pH of the pool water may rise as a normal reaction to the introduction of **ProTeam Supreme**. After a normal turnover of pool water adjust the pH to 7.4-7.6 using a reliable acid demand kit. **ProTeam Supreme** is compatible with all materials normally used in swimming pool maintenance.

- 3.) Test the pool water a minimum once a week or as normally required by local Health Authority Regulations. Sanitizer levels need to be maintained at levels indicated on the sanitizer label. The **ProTeam Supreme** residual must be tested at least once each month and must be maintained at 30-50 ppm. Your ProTeam Dealer can provide this test and water analysis.
- 4.) **ProTeam Supreme** is lost from water only through filter backwash and splash-out.

WINTERIZATION

A pool that has been treated with **ProTeam Supreme** will remain clear and be beautiful throughout the winter months with little or no effort. The pool must be tested to assure that an adequate level of **ProTeam Supreme** is present before shut down. See your ProTeam Dealer for freeze protection information.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
