Pools with heavy algae growth should be vacuumed. If the pool is properly equipped, algae growth should be vacuumed directly out of the pool to waste.

TREATMENT OF VISABLE POOL ALGAE: Superchlorinate pool water prior to application of this product and circulate 1 to 2 hours before applying this product. Pools with light to medium pool algae growth, add 4 fluid ounces of [This product]{or}[EPA Registered Product Name per 10,000 gallons of water directly to the pool with the pool pump operating. Pools with heavy algae growth, add 8 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Brush pool surfaces to increase circulation and to remove algae from pool walls and bottoms. Black algae must be brushed vigorously before and after application for best results. After applying [This product]{or}[EPA Registered Product Name], continuously operate pool pump for 48 hours. In cases of persistent algae, repeat brushing and product application after 3-4 days. Once pool is clear, clean the filter with a cleaning solution for swimming pool filters.

Adjust pH of pool water to or between 7.2-7.6, total alkalinity 80-120 ppm and calcium water hardness 200-400 ppm. Pools should be brushed down and free from any floating or surface debris.
