**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Application to Skin:** Squeeze a few drops into hands and apply to all exposed skin. Rub in well and wipe or wash palms after applying. For chiggers and ticks, apply around all clothing openings.

**Don't over apply!** A few drops go a long way.

**Application to Great Canadian Bug Jacket or Pants:** Place jacket/pants in storage bag and lay flat. Squirt 1/4 of the contents on one side of fabric. Turn bag over and squirt 1/4 of the contents on other side of fabric. Seal bag. Ready for use in 4 hours.

**Recharging:** Follow above steps. Recharge only with Great Canadian Bug Repellent. Return jacket/pants to storage bag after each use.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**CAUTION:** Keep out of eyes, lips and mouth. Harmful if swallowed. In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. May cause skin reaction in rare cases. Avoid contact with plastics and fabrics such as acetate, rayon and dynel. Will not damage nylon, cotton or wool.
