**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling. Have available gas masks approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines or the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. Handle and use only in accordance with recommended in the Chlorine Manual published by the Chlorine Institute Inc. New York. Use only in well ventilated areas.

Only specifically designed dispensing equipment should be used in accordance with manufacturers instructions and according to state regulatory agency recommendations for dosages or residual chlorine levels which should be maintained for each specific site of application.

Repackagers and reformulators must obtain their own registration from the Environmental Protection Agency.

Containers must not be stored where they will be exposed to temperatures warmer than 54.5 c (130 F) Containers to be returned should be identified with DOT Tag or label and shipped in accordance with suppliers instructions. Cylinders should be segregated from other compressed gases and never stored near hydrocarbons, finely divided metals, turpentine, ether, anhydrous ammonia or other flammable materials. 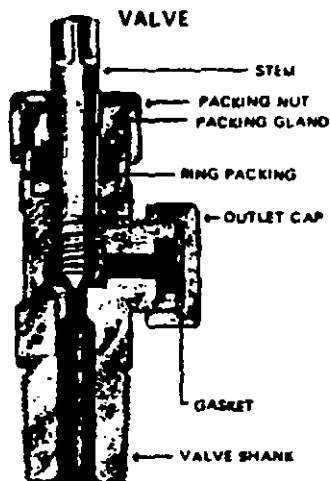
