This technical-grade product may be used in traps and lures without further registration requirements when it is the only active ingredient in accordance with 40CFR 152.25(b).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store pesticides away from food, pet food, feed, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies. Store in a well ventilated area. Protect from ignition sources.
