skin 2-3 inches inward along edge of the uniform at collar,
sleeve cuff, and trouser cuff. Do not use under clothing.
Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for
effectiveness. Avoid overexposure and contact with eyes
and lips. Wipe hands after application. After returning
indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash
treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin
