On behalf of our client, 3M, we are notifying EPA of the consolidation of all previous approved changes made to the 3M Ultrathon Insect Repellent label in the enclosed Master Label. This label includes all approved and notified changes since reregistration of the product. Additionally, we are formally notifying EPA of the addition of the phrase "Time Release" to the label, to be used as an alternative for the marketing phrase "Controlled Release." While this language was included in the most recent notification for the 3M Ultrathon Insect Repellent label with the sponge applicator, and approved, we neglected to mention this intended change explicitly before now.
