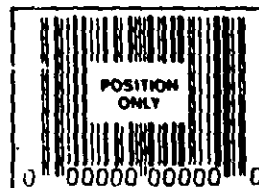

Do not spray directly on face. **TO APPLY TO FACE:** spray into palm of hand and spread evenly on face and neck. **DO NOT APPLY TO EYES OR MOUTH.** For best protection spread evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin. **WORKS ON CLOTHING, TOO.** Spray shirts, pants, cuffs, socks and around other openings in outer clothing. Do not use under c-strings. **WILL NOT DAMAGE** nylon, cotton or wool fabrics. **MAY DAMAGE** other synthetic fabrics, plastics, watch crystals, leather, painted or varnished surfaces. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. **STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Store away from heat or flame in an area inaccessible to children.
