On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

  - 2. Make the following label changes:

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c. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" section so that it reads:

"Warning: For external use only. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or mouth. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Harmful if swallowed. Remove treated clothing and wash before reuse."

d. Revise the "Statement of Practical Treatment" so that it reads:

"If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention. If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. If on skin: Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child are reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call a poison control center or a doctor. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you."

- 3. Submit a corrected confidential statement of formula (CSF) for this product that:
  - a. Adequately identifies the fragrance contained in the product. The CSF (dated 4/12/95) indicates only that the ingredient is "fragrance". Per 40 CFR 152, the registration application must contain a complete and accurate description of the ingredients in a product.
  - b. Corrects the identification information for the source of the Deet. EPA Registration No. 83401-39 is not a valid number.
- 4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
