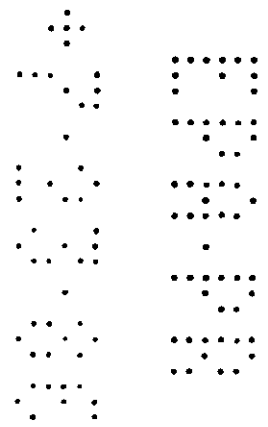

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PECAN INSECT CONTROL

For control of Phylloxera (Galls) and the Hickory Shoot Curculio - Mix 1 quart in 100 gallons of water (2 teaspoonfuls pr gallon of water). Apply with a power sprayer in the spring as a "Bud Break" spray (early to mid-April when bud break is no more than 2 inches long) making only one application thoroughly wetting all portions of the tree and new bud growth. Plan on using approximately 10 to 15 gallons of diluted spray per bearing tree when planted on 60 foot center (approx. 24 trees per acre.). Do not exceed 450 gallons of dilute spray per acre. Do not graze treated areas. NOTE This control is not effective when typical gall symptoms appear.
