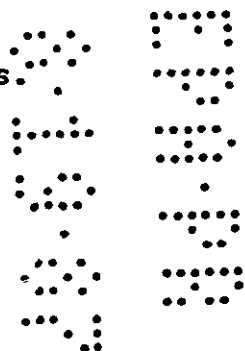

**BACK PANEL - Vet's Choice Flea & Tick Spray for Pets**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT**

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 7 days on dogs and cats.

**DOG & CATS:** Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat as needed.

For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs.

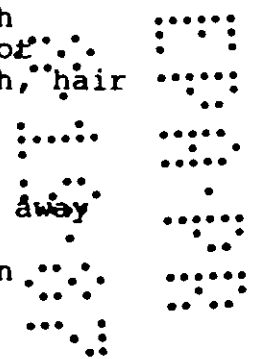
**PUPPIES & KITTENS:** Spray only on back and rub in with finger tips. Do not treat nursing kittens and puppies.

**PET SLEEPING QUARTERS:** Remove old pet bedding and wash thoroughly. Thoroughly spray area and replace with new bedding which has been sprayed. Make sure spray has dried before allowing pets to reoccupy the area.

**HORSES & PONIES:** Apply by either spray or soft cloth method. **Spray Method:** Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches giving special attention to facial areas, shoulders, neck, back, shanks and other areas of animal where insects are most often seen. Avoid contact with animals' eyes and nostrils. Apply thoroughly to moisten hair but do not completely wet skin. Repeat application as necessary. **Soft Cloth Method:** Brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten, but do not soak, a piece of turkish toweling. Rub against, then with, hair growth. Repeat application as necessary.

**STORAGE:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and sunlight. Protect from freezing (32 F).

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash.

CAUTION: Harmful in inhaled. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens under 3 months of age. Do not use on horses intended for food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Inhaled: Discontinue spraying and remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if warranted.
If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area with plenty of soap and water. Call a physician if irritation develops or persists. Wash clothing prior to re-use.
