This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 6(c)(1)(A) in order that you:



**DIRECTIONS FOR**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide inconsistent with its labeling.

PMC CM35 is used in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 1.5 PMC CM35 per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 0.5 PMC CM35 per 1000 gallons every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency and relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the additions should be made in the sump of water.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack and should not be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a container closed when not in use.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a valuable resource.
