Temporary Pools of Standing Water: Apply ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 at a rate of 170 lbs AP-50 per acre (85 lbs a.i. per acre) of water surface when depth < 1 inch, at 3-4 week intervals. Adjust timing of subsequent applications as required by bird activity and anticipated seasonal migrations. For pools of water 2-3 inches deep, apply ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 at a rate of 340-514 lbs AP-50 per acre (170-257 lbs a.i. per acre) of water surface. Do not add additional product if there is no bird activity.

Landfills: Mix 50-150 lbs (25-75 lbs a.i.) of ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 with each 500 gal of landfill cover spray (such as DayControl® or ConCover® from New Waste Concepts, Inc.) for each 5,000 sqft of working face per day.
