STORAGE & DISPOSAL

WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, or on clothing. ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 has been formulated from Food Grade ingredients that meet or exceed U.S. Food Chemical Codex (FCC) and U.S. Pharmacopeia (USP) specifications and comply with the British Pharmacopeia.

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children, pets, and domestic animals. Store apart from pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed that may cause cross-contamination from odor. Keep container closed when not in use.

REPELLENT DISPOSAL: Spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved State procedures. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may be used to repel ring-billed gulls, Canada geese, and mallards from temporary pools of standing water and landfills that are not in or bordering airports.

Temporary Pools of Standing Water: Apply ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 at a rate of 170 lbs AP-50 per acre (85 lbs a.i. per acre) of water surface when depth < 1 inch, at 3-4 week intervals. Adjust timing of subsequent applications as required by bird activity and anticipated seasonal migrations. For pools of water 2-3 inches deep, apply ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 at a rate of 340 lbs AP-50 per acre (170 lbs a.i. per acre) of water surface. Do not add additional product if there is no bird activity.

Landfills: Mix 50-150 lbs (25-75 lbs a.i.) of ReJeX-iT™ AP-50 with each 500 gal of landfill cover spray (such as DayControl® or ConCover® from New Waste Concepts, Inc.) for each 5,000 sq ft of working face per day.

Mix product outside or in ventilated area.
