HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may be used to repel Canada geese from golf courses and other turf areas. This product must be applied using appropriate spray equipment. Best applied by spray equipment, such as any garden pump sprayer or commercial power sprayer such as a power blast.

DILUTION DIRECTIONS: Mix ReJeX-IT™ AG-36 with water at a ratio of 1 part product to 3 parts water. For example, mix 1 quart of product with 3 quarts of water to make 1 gallon of spray mixture. Mix product outside or in ventilated area.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Apply at a rate of 80-95 lb AG-36 (38-48 gallons of spray mixture, 11.6-13.8 lbs a.i.) per acre of turf area. Spray evenly on area to be protected to provide thorough coverage and allow material to dry before permitting human activity on treated area. Repeat every 4 days or as warranted by Canada goose activity. Do not apply when grass is wet or when rain is expected. Do not mow the treated area for several days after application.
