PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT APPLICATORS AND OTHER HANDLERS MUST WEAR:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Waterproof gloves
- Shoes plus socks
- Protective eyewear
- Dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C)

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

GENERAL: Use 700 milliliters (1 1/2 pints) of product per acre for each application. Start applications at the beginning of egg hatch of the first generation. Repeat applications at 3-10 day intervals as long as egg laying is taking place.

SPRAY PREPARATION: Clean and calibrate sprayer. Fill mixing tank with one-half of the water to be used. Start agitation in tank. Add a spreader sticker, such as NuFilm-P or equivalent, according to product's label instructions. Add recommended amount of product. Continue agitation until thoroughly mixed. Spray tank mixture should not exceed pH 8.0.

APPLICATION: Calibrate sprayer. Make sure all nozzles are functional. Use sufficient water per acre to obtain thorough coverage while minimizing runoff. The diluted mixture should not be allowed to remain in the mixing tank for more than 24 hours.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

STORAGE: Store in freezer or refrigerator. Use within 1 day after removal from storage. Bioactivity may be impaired by storage. Bioactivity may be impaired by storage above 90° Fahrenheit. Storing the product in a freezer or refrigerator will extend its shelf-life.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities by burning. If burning is allowed, stay out of smoke.
