 Your Submission Dated January 13, 1993

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Under Environmental Hazards, add "Do not apply within 25 feet of any body of water where fish are taken for human consumption. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark." Change the second sentence to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
 - b. Under "Snow Mold", delete the reference to a sand carrier.
2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER

Poisonous and corrosive. Do not swallow, inhale or get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. May be fatal if swallowed. Causes burns, do not get on skin. Do not breathe dust. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Keep product and clippings from treated areas out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water supplies by cleaning equipment or waste disposal. Keep container closed and safely stored at all times it is not in use.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. To be applied only by or under direct supervision of golf course superintendents. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Not sensitive to light. Stable at normal temperatures and humidities. Store in a dry place and in a well-closed container.

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open-dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Rinse sprayer or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If drums cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

SNOW MOLD

For treatment of golf course greens, tees and a mold is a threat, the following preventive treatment should be applied to the turf before ground freezes or before a heavy snow apply approaches at the rate of 3 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. of turf. An additional application of CALO-CLOR assures added protection. Apply uniformly.

WET APPLICATION

Determine quantity of CALO-CLOR required, according to the recommendations above. Measure this amount in a clean, dry, metallic container, add water and stir until a thick slurry is formed. Add to the spray tank, using 5 to 10 gallons of water for each 10 quarts of CALO-CLOR sand mixture. Start the agitator and slowly add the CALO-CLOR sand mixture. Mix thoroughly before applying. Thoroughly wash sprayer and all metal connections.

DRY APPLICATION

Add recommended amount of CALO-CLOR to each 10 quarts of turf to be treated. Mix thoroughly that each 10 quarts of CALO-CLOR sand mixture. Better control may be achieved if a light watered CALO-CLOR sand mixture.

Caution Regarding Use With Fertilizers

Experience has shown that injury attributed to turf by fertilizers or weed killers. Avoid applying CALO-CLOR fertilizers such as urea ammonium sulfate, ammonium phosphate, or with weed killers.
