



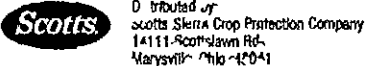

KOBAN 30 is intended for use on ornamental turf which is subject to Pythium blight, damping off, cottony blight and Pythium Root and Crown Rot. It may be used at time of seeding to control damping off, or on establishing turf to prevent or control Pythium blight (cottony blight and Pythium Root and Crown Rot).

KOBAN 30 does not afford broad spectrum fungus disease control for Rhizoctonia (brown patch), Sclerotinia (dollar spot), Gloeosporangium (copper spot), and similar turf diseases. A fungicide program to control these diseases should be followed if they co-exist with Pythium blight.

For use on golf course greens, tees and fairways.

For control of Pythium blight (cottony blight), grease spot, damping off and Pythium Root and Crown Rot on turf.

Night temperature above 60°F (15.5°C) will be inhibited by and increase for Pythium development.

Add KOBAN 30 to the spray tank with the agitator in operation. Dispense 2 to 4 1/2 oz. of KOBAN 30 in 5 gallons of water for each 1000 sq. ft. of turf to be treated. Use 2 oz./1000 sq. ft. when disease incidence is expected to be light and 4 1/2 oz./1000 sq. ft. for more severe conditions.

For Pythium Root and Crown Rot apply KOBAN 30 at 5-6 oz. in 5 gallons of water per 1000 sq. ft. Drench (irrigate) the treated area immediately following application to increase performance. During periods of high drought temperatures (90°-95°F) apply KOBAN 30 in early morning or late afternoon.

Apply uniformly to the turf area with a SPRAYHAWK mobile spray booth or other suitable equipment.

Re-treat in 5 to 10 days, depending upon climatic conditions, to maintain disease control. KOBAN 30 should not be mixed with other pesticides or fertilizers.

For control of damping-off in newly seeded areas: Apply 7 to 9 oz. of KOBAN 30 in 5 to 10 gallons of water/1000 sq. ft. immediately after seeding. Irrigate promptly for improved soil penetration of the fungicide and to initiate seed germination. Re-treat at 5 to 7 day intervals at the 2 to 4 1/2 oz. rate in order to maintain a preventative disease control program after germination.

Use FURCO® 50 D, VILAN® or VILAN® for control of a broad spectrum of diseases other than Pythium.
