NOTE TO USER: Undiluted Milban® is corrosive, causes severe eye damage which may result in loss of vision. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and full covering protective clothing. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Do not re-enter treated greenhouse or begin routine maintenance or handling of plants until the spray has fully dried. Workmen should be alerted to wash their hands thoroughly after handling treated plants.

Milban® is for control of powdery mildew on Roses grown commercially in greenhouses. Sensitivity has been found on the varieties Tropicana, Matador and Jack Frost. When using on new varieties, treat a few plants prior to adopting for general application.

Milban® is effective against powdery mildew on Grape Ivy, Kalanchoe, Melenchae, Chrysanthemum, Begonia and African Violet in greenhouses.

To minimize possible plant damage under hot, sunny conditions the humidity in the greenhouse should be increased several hours before treatment. Do not treat plants under any stress condition.

Spray in early morning or on overcast days, when possible.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention, preferably by an ophthalmologist.
IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white or gelatin solution. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call physician immediately.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
IF ON SKIN: Immediately wash affected area with plenty of soap and water.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Washing of eyes with water has minimum benefits and must be considered in treatment of conjunctivitis, iritis and corneal ulcerations. Ocular toxicity is directly related to length of contact. Possible mucosal damage may compromise the patient's vision. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE - Cont'd.

With the sprayer agitator operating, prepare a spray solution of 32 fl oz (0.95L) in 100 gal (378L) of water. Spray to thoroughly cover the foliage. Treat at 10 to 14 day intervals under conditions favorable to powdery mildew. If mildew is already present, treatment should be made at weekly intervals until disease is under control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store at temperatures above 32° F (0° C)

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
