STORAGE: Do not store near seeds or fertilizer. Keep container closed when not in use.

SIDE DRESS APPLICATIONS: Open a furrow 8-10 inches to the side of the plant to a depth of 4-6 inches. Band 6 oz of BANROT 8-G per 100 linear ft using suitable equipment and a diluent. Cover the band and pack firmly. Repeat the operations on the other side of the plant bed. Irrigate to ensure activation of the BANROT 8-G.
