When usage rate recommendations are followed, ALFA-SAVE will protect hay through the curing/drying process when adequately protected from weather.

APPLICATION:

Uniform distribution is very important. They hay should be raked into medium-sized, fluffy windrows. A 3-nozzle boom should be attached to the baler pick-up such that hay is sprayed while still fluffy so the spray can penetrate the windrow. Fan-type nozzles should be used with a minimum pressure of 20 lbs. per square inch. Flood type nozzles are not satisfactory.
