

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

USE DIRECTIONS: Before use, consult Ferro Data Sheet describing proper preparation and application. Do not apply below 60°F or above 90°F.

This product conforms to the standards described in our Ferro Data Sheets. It should be tested by the user to insure conformance to his specific requirements.

NOTE: When product is used in confined areas or applied by spraying, use adequate ventilation or wear a respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provision of 30 CFR 11.

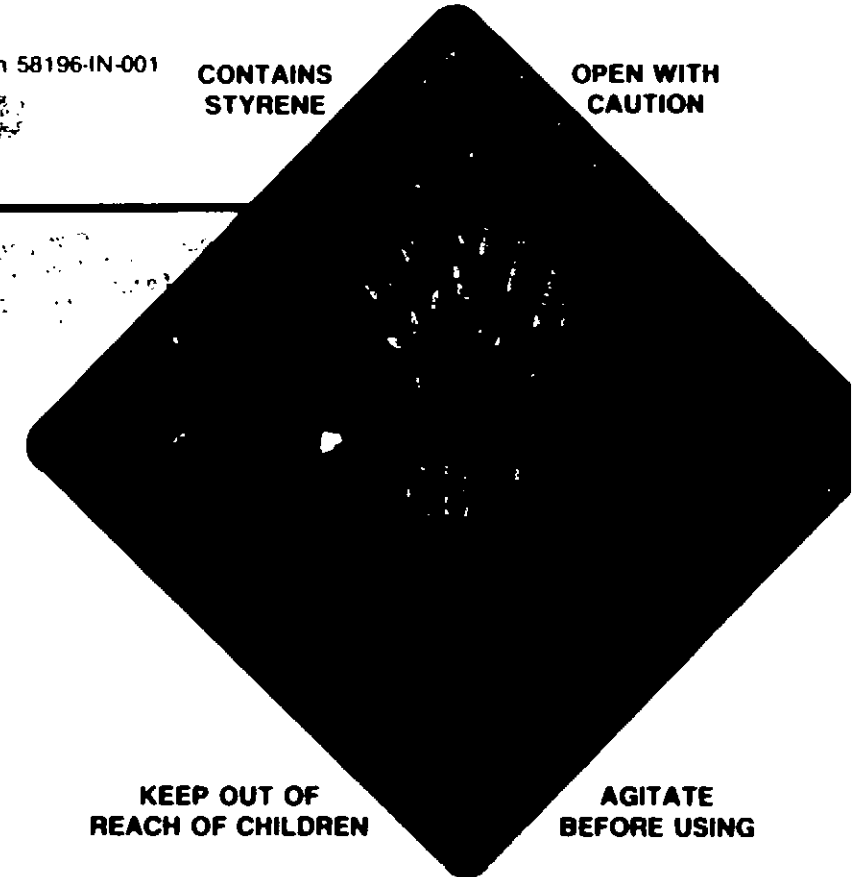

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- e. The preferred declaration of the Active Ingredient is "Copper Powder."
- f. In the left panel, replace the Environmental Hazards paragraph with the below recommended paragraph:

This material is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

- g. Delete the first sentence of the Use Directions "This product is composed of unreacted materials" since this is ambiguous.
- h. Submit for your file the "Ferro Data Sheets" referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 of the "Use Directions."
- i. Rearrange and correct the Storage and Disposal statements as:
 - 1) Place the storage paragraph first.
 - 2) Add the "Pesticide Disposal" heading introducing the paragraph "Pesticide Wastes . . . for guidance."
 - 3) In the container disposal statement expand the first sentence to "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by Storage or Disposal."

3. We note that your application gives the product name as "Crystic Copper Clad C70PA" whereas your DRAFT label gives the product name as "Crystic Copper Clad Antifouling." The application and label must reflect your choice.

4. Refer to the enclosure, "THE LABEL" and make sure that you have complied with the type size requirements and following items: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6a, 6b, 7, 7a, 7b, 7d, 7e, 8, 8a, 8b, 9c, 10c, and 10d. 5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
