THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS CHLOROPICRIN WHICH MAY BE IRRITATING TO THE UPPER RESPIRATORY TRACT, AND EVEN AT LOW LEVELS CAN CAUSE PAINFUL IRRITATION TO THE EYES, PRODUCING TEARING. IF THESE SYMPTOMS OCCUR, LEAVE THE FUMIGATION AREA IMMEDIATELY. EARLY SYMPTOMS OF CHLOROPICRIN OVEREXPOSURE ARE LACHRYMATION, RESPIRATORY DISTRESS AND VOMITING.

OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS

1. Do not get in eyes, in mouth or on clothing.
2. Do not split, or discharge material outside of areas confined for treatment.
3. Comply with all local regulations and ordinances.
4. It is advisable to supply your physician with information on Chloropicrin and methyl bromide literature is available from your dealer or distributor.
5. Use medical assistance at once if you have symptoms after exposure, and do not allow conditions which could accidentally cause further exposure such as fire, heat, etc. See Note to Physician.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION

If the concentration of methyl bromide in the working area, as measured by a direct-reading detector device, such as a trigger gas detector, does not exceed 1 ppm, SCBA or respirator protection is required. If this concentration is exceeded at any time, all persons in the fumigation area must wear protective clothing and a HIGH MVA approved self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) or continuous air-supplied respirator equipped with a full face mask survival or respirator device.

Under normal soil fumigation conditions, the concentration of methyl bromide in the working area will not generally exceed 1 ppm as a time-weighted average and no respiratory protection is required. However, there is the possibility of a build up of gas during soil fumigation. Therefore, a HIGH MVA continuous air supplied SCBA respirator, when available, and will be required for entry into affected areas in the event of a leak or spill.

CLOTHING PRECAUTIONS

1. Wear long sleeves, long pants, socks, shoes and a hat.
2. Wear a respirator mask.
3. Wear a respirator mask.
4. If liquid gets on skin, wash immediately with soap and water.

SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURE

1. If liquid gets on skin, wash immediately with soap and water.
2. If liquid gets in eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes.
3. If liquid gets in mouth, flush immediately with copious amounts of water.
4. If liquid gets on clothing, wash immediately with soap and water.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED Get exposed person to fresh air. Keep warm. Make sure person can breathe freely. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. Give oxygen if needed. Do not give anything by mouth to any unconscious person. Seek medical attention.

IF ON SKIN Immediately remove contaminated clothing, shoes, and other items covering the skin. Wash contaminated skin area thoroughly with soap and water.

IF IN EYES Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for at least 15 minutes.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN Early symptoms of overexposure are: Irritancy, headache, nausea and vomiting, weakness, and collapse. Lung edema may develop in 2 to 48 hours after exposure, accompanied by cardiac irregularities. These effects are the usual cause of death. Repeated overexposure can result in blurred vision, staggering gait, and mental imbalance. With probable recovery after a period of one week. Blood bromide levels suggest the current or recent level of exposure. Treatment is symptomatic.

AERATION: Remove tarpaulin after 48 hours. Follow the soil to aerate for two weeks before planting. If odors or fumigant persist beyond this two-week period, disc or plow the soil to help aeration.

**FOR USE WEST OF ROCKY MOUNTAINS
ONIONS, DIRECT SEEDED**

APPLICATION: Treatment can be made whenever soil conditions are suitable. In northern states, late summer or early fall treatments are best for land to be planted to early spring crops. Follow application directions as described above.

USE DOSAGE: For control of White Rot, weeds (grasses) and Nematodes. 375 lbs/Acre

LIMITATION: Use restricted to west of the Rocky Mountains. Do not treat any field more than once every twelve months.

ASPARAGUS AND LETTUCE**

APPLICATION: Follow application directions as described above.
