Subject: Revised Labeling in Response to PR Notice 91-7
Camicide Pyrethrin Formula 2X
EPA Reg. No. 58284-3
Submission dated October 19, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Delete petroleum distillate from the active ingredient declaration on the label, and add the corresponding percentage to the inert ingredients. If you choose not to include the petroleum distillate with the inert ingredients, you are responsible for any data required to support its re-registration as an active ingredient.
- 2) Modify the existing precautionary statement, "Any exposed utensils or food handling surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before using", to read: "Any exposed utensils or food handling surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using".
- 3) Modify the Environmental Hazards statement to read: "This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply to water. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters."

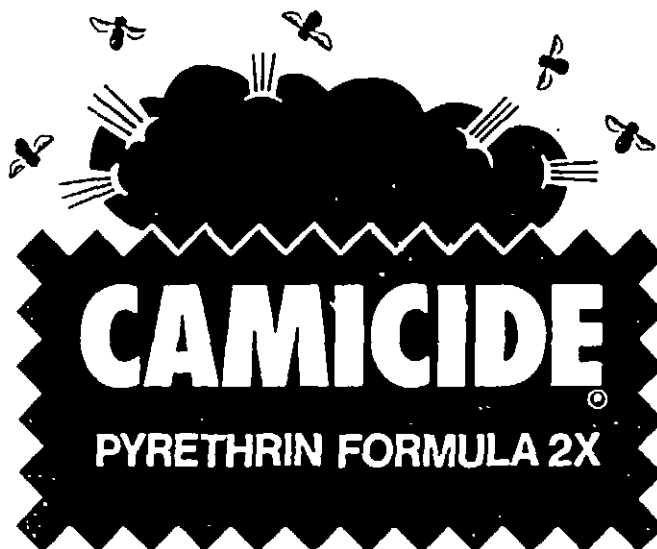

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this in a manner inconsistent with its label.

SHAKE BEFORE USING

Kills exposed or accessible stages of flying insects when used as directed.

TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, and WATER BEETLES: Apply thoroughly to infested areas containing many insects as possible. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, and hidden areas behind appliances, furniture, and around drains in warm, moist, or dark areas. Treat points of entry and trails when possible. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMILING MOTH, WEBBING CLOTHES and GNATS: Close all doors and windows. Remove exposed food, utensils, and fish aquariums. Direct spray upward into center of room in slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds per average room. Exit room and keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room completely before re-entry. Avoid breathing. Remove and destroy downed insects.

TO KILL FLEAS: Remove and destroy bedding and thoroughly spray kennel or quarters. Spray cracks and crevices to kill hidden insects. Allow spray to dry and replace clean bedding when surfaces are dry. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Directly to many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture, and the bottoms of rugs and carpets. Pay special attention to closets, shelves, borders of areas, and areas under furniture. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF COCKROACHES, FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED BEETLES, LESSER GRAIN BORER, and WEEVILS: Find and destroy infested goods. Remove all other items from area and treat. Spray shelves and floors in pantries, closets and shelves for warehouse stock. Surfaces to dry completely before replacing paper, utensils, or food items. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL WASPS: Spray nests in early morning or late evening when insects are less active. Contact as many insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Disposal: Do Not Reuse Empty Container. Wrap and Put in Trash Container.
 Storage: Store in a Cool Dry Place. Container Closed.
