CAUTION! Avoid breathing of vapor or contact with eyes or skin. Vacate premises after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. In hospitals, remove patients from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs. Cover or remove food before using. After using this product, food contact surfaces and equipment must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
Do not use in areas where fish or reptiles may be exposed to the spray. Do not spray directly on plants or shrubbery.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
Do not store near fire, flame, sparks, or heated surfaces. Turn off electrical equipment in the use area. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, relight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposures to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
If Swallowed: Contact a physician or poison control center immediately.
If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION:
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kills exposed or accessible stages of the insects when used as directed. **SHAKE BEFORE USING.**
TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FISH, SPIDERS and WATERBUGS: Apply to infested areas contacting as many insect hiding places as possible. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices and behind appliances, furniture, and around warm, moist or dark areas. Treat points when possible. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL FLEAS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLIES and GNATS: Close all doors and windows. Direct spray into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Hold nozzle for 10 seconds for average room. Exit room and close door for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room before re-entry. Avoid breathing and destroy downed insects.

TO KILL FLEAS: Remove and destroy bedding and thoroughly spray kennel or sleeping quarters. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices and under furniture. Replace clean bedding when dry. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL FLEAS ON DOGS: Spray lightly on dog's body. Direct spray away from face.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Directly on insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of stored furniture, and the tops and bottoms of carpets. Pay special attention to closets, drawers, and areas under furniture. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSION AGENTS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, GRAIN BORER, and RICE WEEVILS: For infested package goods. Remove all other goods from area to be treated. Spray shelves and floor. Dry completely before replacing shelf. Repeat as needed.

TO KILL WASPS: Spray nests in early morning when insects are less active. Collect insects as possible. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Put in trash collection. Do not incinerate container.
Storage: Store in a cool dry place. Keep container closed.
