2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 58284-17".
- b. Delete the phrase, **Pleasantly Scented**, since a fragrance has not been identified in your confidential statement of formula.
- c. We assume you have supporting efficacy demonstrating the effectiveness of this product to residually kill the listed pests up to six weeks. If this is not the case this residual claim must be deleted.

- d. Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, add the following statements:
- o Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.
  - o Do not apply to classrooms when in use.
  - o Use in well ventilated areas.
- e. Delete the statement, General Classification, because pesticide product are no longer classified for general use.
- f. The sentence should read: **Spray surfaces until wet but do not allow runoff to occur.**
- g. Please qualify the word **food** with the phrase, **food/feed**, wherever it appears on the labeling, i.e. **Nonfood/Nonfeed Areas, food/feed areas** etc.
- h. Use in food handling establishments can imply use in the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement **"Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants"** or submit an application to USDA requesting these areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION! May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

**GENERAL:** Use Camicide as a crack and crevice treatment to kill silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects. Use product only as a coarse spray in localized areas where pests are found. Do not use on faces until wet. Repeat as needed.

**For Spot Treatment:**  
**TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, SPIDERS, SOWBUGS AND CRACKLEDOGS:** Apply spray in areas where these pests are found or where they enter. In rooms and closets; cracks and crevices; under boards and door and window frames; under stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; behind plumbing and other utility installations. In places should be sprayed directly around doors and windows and under them to find entrance. Repeat as needed.

**TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS:** Use as a spot treatment to infested areas such as bedrooms, quarters, nearby cracks and crevices; under boards, window and door frames; under floor coverings where these pests are found. Carpet should be removed and replaced after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS.**

**For Crack and Crevice:**  
**TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, BROWN DOGS AND PET BEETLES:** Apply spray in cracks and crevices. Also apply in porches, basements, construction, between equipment, under floor coverings to voids and hollow spaces where the above listed insects are found. Care should be taken to avoid exposed surfaces or introduction of contamination of food or food products.

**FLIES AND MOSQUITOES:** Use as a spot treatment to reduce annoyance from these insects. Apply spray to window and door frames as well as other areas where they enter the home. Also spray da areas (such as under eaves) where these insects may congregate. Repeat as needed. Do not allow to rest on treated surface until necessary.
