d. Add the following to the first paragraph under Directions for Use:

Use rubber gloves. Work in a well ventilated area.

e. Add the following to "To Kill Fleas, Lice, and Ticks:"

Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling

f. Delete "long lasting" from "gives long lasting residual control." You may wish to specify how long the product is effective.

g. All products where precautionary labeling appears on other than the front panel must bear the following statement:

See side (back) panel for additional precautionary statements.

h. Replace the phrase "Evercide Pet Dip Concentrate 2464" with the correct name for this product; also delete the reference to "Evercide" on the front panel since it is not applicable to this labeling.

i. Please verify that the correct and complete company address appears on the label.

3. Submit 5 copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Shake EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution. or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

EVERCIDE Pet Dip Concentrate 2464 gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
