- g. Delete the phrase "This product is to be used only....for home use."
- h. Revise the subheading "Disposal of Spent Media" to read as follows: "Disposal."
- i. Revise the " Disposal statement" to read as follows:

Disposal-Wrap exhausted filter in newspaper and discard in the trash.
