DIRECTIONS

This product is for use as a disinfectant or repackaging water disinfectant. Repackagers must comply with the Environmental Protection Agency requirements.

STORAGE

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Avoid contact with metallic containers. The action of Iodine on polyethylene containers (preferably with a plastic liner) storing resin above the water level. Do not allow resin to be exposed to direct sunlight. Do not open or unlabeled.
